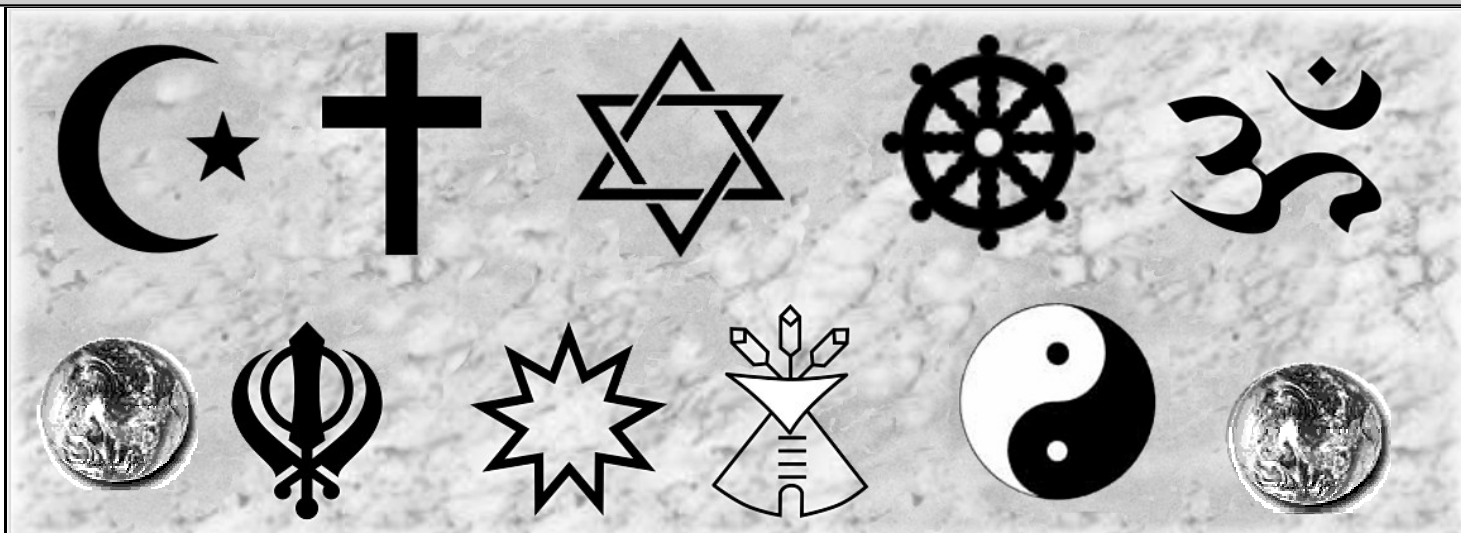


International Conference on
